NEW E-SIGN YOUR MPN WITH OUR PREFERRED LENDERS

You can now complete and sign your Stafford Loan MPN online with selected lenders. This option allows you to speed up the application process and delivery of funds. When completing the MPN online, make sure to have your Department of Education PIN (Personal Identification Number) ready. If you don't have a PIN or cannot remember it, go to www.pin.ed.gov to request one.

Citibank

(You can also sign your MPN online using Citibank's real-time process.)

1. Go to www.studentloan.com, register online and follow the directions provided on the site. These directions will request information such as the school you are attending.
2. You will be directed to the "Available Loans" page. Here you will see a list of loans for which you are eligible to apply.
3. Select the link that says "You can apply now using our online application" under "Federal PLUS Loan" on the "Available Loans" page.
4. Fill in the information requested on the online MPN form.
5. Once you have completed the online application, you are presented with the option to sign your MPN online.
6. Simply select the "e-signature" option and follow the steps for signing your MPN online. Before you know it, the application process is complete.

**If you are not sure you meet the credit requirement, you may select the "Federal PLUS Pre-screen" option under the "Applying for a Loan" tab across the top of the page and complete the prescreen before completing the MPN.

If you are unsure about using the electronic process or prefer a paper MPN, you may call Citibank toll-free at 1-800-967-2400.

College Foundation, Inc.

Go to www.CFNC.org and follow these steps:

1. If you do not already have an account, create a "MYCFNC" account. Having an account will enable you to check on your application or loan status later. The information you enter in your MYCFNC will pre-fill any forms you complete on the site. Use your full name (not nickname) and be sure your address, birth date, SSN and phone number are entered correctly.
 2. From the CFNC.org homepage, click on "Apply for Loans" or "Online Applications".
 3. Click on "Complete PLUS Loan Master Promissory Note (MPN)." If you are a first time applicant, you will complete the full form; if you already have a PLUS MPN on file with College Foundation for this student, you will submit a loan request, and no signature will be required.
 4. Review your pre-filled sections for accuracy and complete any missing items.
 5. To use your electronic signature, choose the PIN option. You will be redirected to the FAFSA Student Authentication Network page. Enter the required information. Once your PIN is verified, you will come back to the CFNC website. Submit your signature, and you are all done.
- **If you are not sure whether you meet the credit requirement for a PLUS Loan, select "Federal PLUS Loan" from the left navigation and look for the "Pre-screening Option." You may also download and mail or fax a pre-screen request.
